2. Background

The Enfield Volunteer Fire Department wishes to tender for the sale of one **(1) E-One 1998 International 4900 50 Foot Aerial Truck** and further outlined under Item # 12 Specifications

3. Registration, Delivery and Opening

Tenders must be submitted in a sealed envelope and shall be clearly marked as to the contents including tender reference number **FD-01-2018**, and addressed to:

Tenders will be received by the Enfield Volunteer Fire Department on or before 4:00 PM local time on Tuesday, February 20, 2018. The use of mail for delivery of a proposal will be at the risk of the proponent. Submissions sent by facsimile or e-mail or other electronic means will **NOT** be accepted

4. Disqualification of Proponents

Under no circumstances will tenders be considered which are received after **4:00 PM, local time, on Tuesday, February 20, 2018**

5. Amendment and Withdrawal of Tenders

Only one tender per proponent will be accepted. A proponent who has already submitted a tender may submit a further tender at any time up to the official closing time. The last tender received shall supersede and invalidate all tenders previously submitted by that proponent for this contract.

6. Informal or Unbalanced Tenders

All entries in the Tender Form shall be made in black ink or typed. Entries or changes made in pencil, or are incomplete, illegible or obscure will be deemed invalid, any erasures or alterations (unless properly and clearly made and initialed by the bidder) or irregularities of any kind may be rejected.

There shall be no obligation on the Enfield Volunteer Fire Department to advise any proponent of the reason why any tender is rejected or to justify the rejection of any tender.

7. Tender Form

Each proponent shall include a completed tender form found herein. The proponent shall give the total tender price and shall fill in all blank spaces and any other information requested on the Tender Form.

8. Right to accept or Reject a Tender

The highest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The Department has the right to reject any and all tenders for any reason whatsoever. The Department shall not be responsible for, and proponents shall not be entitled to reimbursement for any liabilities costs, expenses, losses or damages incurred, sustained or suffered by any proponent prior or subsequent to, or by reason of the acceptance or non-acceptance by the Department of any tender, or by reason of any delay in the acceptance of the tender.

9. Agreement and Payment

The sale of this Fire Truck is on a (as is), (where is) basis, The Fire Truck will not be released until payment is cleared. Payment shall be made when the fire truck is released from the Enfield Volunteer Fire Department, should payment not be received within (10) days then a second bidder shall be offered the truck at the tender price.
