RE: Q & A document/NSIMRS System Update

As we start the New Year, the PSFC Team extends greetings for a safe and prosperous 2016.

Over the past few months our PSFC team has been called upon to respond to various questions or to clarify information regarding the TMR system, radios, procedures etc.

We have compiled a list of these questions and we felt that it was important to share this information with the fire service in the form of a Q&A document. There are references in the Q&A document with respect to the moving of radios between apparatus and/or between stations. We have attached these two documents in this package and we will require you to utilize them as we move forward in TMR2.

We have also attached some updated information on the Nova Scotia Integrated Mobile Radio System (NSIMRS). There has been some significant work completed to upgrade this communications network. We wanted to ensure that fire departments are aware and encouraged to utilize these sites as potential communication networks during incidents, training or planned events.
