Truro, Nova Scotia, January 29th 2007 - Tom Bremner, President of the Fire Service Association of Nova Scotia and County Association representatives completed two days of discussions where they focused on internal items and on what their priority items of attention would be for this year. After approximately 17 hours of closed door discussions the Association 100% committed to three areas of direction for the year 2007, those being;

- 1) Education
- 2) Communications.
- 3) Moving ahead with the creating of minimum Standards for the Fire Service.

President Bremner in reviewing the two day session noted the overwhelming change from past attempts / attitudes in addressing such issues, he noted the strong commitment of all the representatives and listened to a number of moving testimonials towards the need to make contact with all firefighters and let them know what FSANS represents and / or stands for. Secondly the need to have a formulated method of getting communications / messages out to our Firefighters and finally the need to gradually move forward with the creation of Minimum Standards for our Fire Service throughout the Province. It was clearly indicated during this session that all efforts by the attending individuals was to stay focused in representing the needs of our firefighters within this Province and the topic of safety was the driving incentive.
